Dear Ms. Langston Scully:

Attached please find the revised Predesign Investigation Work Plan (PDIWP) for portions of Operable Unit 1/Operable Unit 2 (OU-1/OU-2) of the Anniston PCB Site. The PDIWP was prepared by Pharmacia LLC/Solutia Inc. (P/S) and is being submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for review and approval. The revised PDIWP was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Remedial Design/Remedial Action Consent Decree (CD), including Section 3.3(a) of the Scope of Work (SOW: Appendix B to the CD) and reflects changes to address USEPA comments dated May 3, 2022.

The requisite supporting documents for the PDIWP are consistent with the requirements of Section 6.7 of the SOW. This includes an integrated field sampling plan as Section 3 of the PDIWP, consistent with the requirements of Section 6.7(c) of the SOW, and a Uniform Federal Policy Quality Assurance Project Plan (UFP-QAPP) as Appendix A, meeting the requirements of Section 6.7(d) of the SOW. The PDIWP also includes treatability study work plans for groundwater and sediment as Appendices B and C, respectively. Appendices D and E to the PDIWP provide confined space entry plans that will be used to support field investigative efforts for the Highway 202 culverts and Quintard Mall culvert, respectively.

A response to comments matrix is also attached and describes how the PDIWP and supporting documents were revised to address USEPA's comments dated May 3, 2022.
